ABOUT SUNSHINE COAST CHURCHES SOCCER ASSOCIATION

Sunshine Coast Churches Soccer Association (SCCSA) is dedicated to providing high-quality training for kids of all skill levels. We are passionate about nurturing a love for football and fostering positive relationships under a Christian ethos.

The Sunshine Coast Churches Soccer Association was established on 14th September 1974, and became incorporated on 18th November 1988. Various churches had seen the need for a Saturday soccer competition for some time. In mid-1974, representatives from churches were invited to the informal discussion, and an Association was established. A general meeting was held on 15th November 1974. The Association covered from Caloundra to Cooroy -Noosa recruiting got underway to form two competitions under 10 years and an under 13 years and started with approximately 140 playing members.

Today we have over 3700 junior members and 600 senior male and female players. We provide players with the opportunity to play and develop their soccer skills in safe alcohol and drug-free environments on Friday night and Saturdays. We have 19 clubs covering the entire Sunshine Coast region: Caloundra to Noosa and west to Nambour and the Range.

SCCSA is part of a network of Christian Football Associations all over Australia. In Queensland we have close relationships with Queensland Christian Soccer Association (QCSA) and Baptist Football Queensland (BFQ) with whom we compete at State Carnival. Nationally, Christian Football Federation Australia (CFFA) is a collective of associations voluntarily joined together as one body that provide family friendly and affordable COMMUNITY BASED FOOTBALL competitions in the geographic location they serve.

The SCCSA is a community focused, supportive group that share a passion for football, a commitment to our players and families under a Christian ethos. Together, we create an environment that's not only rewarding for players and coaches, but also genuinely fun to be part of.

The SCCSA is undertaking a tender process for the provision of Football Development and Technical Services for the 2026 and 2027 seasons to support SCCSA Clubs and Football Programs.

POSITION SUMMARY

Providing Football (soccer) Development and Technical Services is an important function within the SCCSA. The provider must ensure players at all age levels are being coached consistently and effectively, in line with the SCCSA overarching vision and Christian philosophy. The service must focus on:

- Improving the level of Football by supporting hundreds of individual coaches across the SCCSA,
- Ensure the development of players across all age groups.
- Uphold the core values and ethos of the SCCSA, whilst ensuring SCCSA coaches do the same.

As the provider of Football Development and Technical Services, it is essential to have a coaching background in youth, school or semi-professional levels. Must possess a well-rounded skill set incorporating player development, performance management whilst maintaining the culture, values and playing philosophy of the SCCSA.

The provider must build and maintain strong, trusted relationships with a range of stakeholders:

- SCCSA Executive and Administration Staff,
- SCCSA Program Managers,
- SCCSA Club Presidents, Committees and Coaches, and
- SCCSA Players and Families.

Duties

The provider will have the exciting opportunity to share a passion for football and work with children. The provider will be responsible for planning and conducting football training sessions, interacting with parents, and ensuring a positive learning environment for our young players.

The provider will be responsible for but not limited to the following (all or part depending on application):

- A) Supply 6 x 2 hour "Introduction to Coaching" courses for SCCSA Club coaches from March to July 2026 for ages Under 6 to Under 10 and Under 11 and older.
- B) Conduct school holiday camps for Junior, Senior or Goal Keepers during:
 - April School holidays
 2 day Junior camp 3hrs per day
 2 day Senior camp 3hrs per day

• July School holidays 2 day Junior camp - 3hrs per day

2 day Senior camp - 3hrs per day

September School holidays
 2 day Junior camp - 3hrs per day

2 day Senior camp - 3hrs per day

- C) Visits to SCCSA Clubs to support Club teams and their coaches:
 - Club visits 2 to 3 per week Tuesday to Thursday (2hrs per visit).
 - Approximately 60 visits.
- D) Supply specialist coaching:
 - 3 goal keeping clinics (2hr each session).
- E) Representative Football:
 - Attend representative team training 10 visits x 2hrs (Monday).
 - Provide 3 courses for coaches 2hrs each.
 - Attend representative trials 3 trials x 6hrs.

The services are to be provided between February - November of 2026 with the opportunity to extend for the 2027 season.
